Robert Andrew Robison, 93, passed away peacefully at Halifax Hospice on January 5th, 2021.

Born in Warren, Ohio on December 7th, 1927, the son of George and Ella Robison, both deceased.

Bob was a graduate of Warren G Harding High School and THE Ohio State University with a Master's Degree in Physical Education in 1959. Bob served in the United States Army thru 1947 and was awarded the World War II Victory Medal. He is survived by his wife and high school sweetheart Gerry and 4 children.
